MEETING NOTES

STRATEGIC GOALS:

Criminal Justice Goal 8: Reduce access to heroin/other illegal opioids. Objectives:

♣ *Develop more connections and strong partnerships with segments of the criminal justice system, i.e.: courts, law enforcement.*

♣ *Establish an array of treatment services (including jail programs) and a process for training of justice system for assessment and linkage to services. See picture below for contributing factors.*

We are needing to update this goal, which was made in 2017. It is felt that the Criminal Justice subcommittee needs to regroup and reconvene. It is felt that it has been successful in reducing access to heroin/other illegal opioids. More strategies need to be developed to include other illicit substances now that we are the Summit County Opiate and Addiction Task Force.

There was discussion of getting to include more probation supervisors on the subcommittee so that information can be effectively distributed to probation officers who often can have significant influence in the life/path of a person in early recovery who is involved with the criminal justice system

Much improvement has occurred at the jail regarding inmates being maintained on MAT, but more work and coordination can happen. See if we can reengage the Sheriff's department.

It was decided to review the email list for the criminal justice subcommittee with co-chairs, Chief Jack Davis and Rhonda Brink and for them to highlight 20 key stakeholders and send out personal invitations to an interim ad hoc meeting for late March/early April, preceding the May 21, 2020 quarterly criminal justice subcommittee meeting.

At this interim ad hoc meeting we will reintroduce the work of the task force and adjust the strategic goal for the subcommittee.

ACTIONS: GET MAILING LIST DISTRIBUTED. SELECT 10-20 attendees (hope 10 will come!) Adjust Strategic goal for next meeting 5/21/20. Goal of having an ad hoc meeting of the Gang of 10 sometime late March/early April.
