## MEETING NOTES

1. Attendees: 9
2. Maternal/Neonatal Updates
  - a. Akron Children's Hospital – new program “Eat, Sleep, Console” which has shown to decrease medication needs and increase bonding in NICU involved infants and families with NAS (Neonatal Abstinence Syndrome)
  - b. Akron Children's Hospital – Doing adolescent detox and outpatient.
3. Adult/Adduction Services
  - a. Portage Path Behavioral Health –
    - i. Reported that they now work transitioning 17.5 year olds to their adult mental health provider. Can work with kids for 6 months before their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday.
    - ii. Doing in-person IOP, MWF from 9-12. Open to referrals.
    - iii. SUD groups on T & H from 10-12
    - iv. MAT – at Barberton and Akron locations
      1. RX availability within 3 days
    - v. “Avenues of Hope” a new women's trauma and recovery group
4. Education and Training
  - a. ECHO – NEOMED - Dr. Goldman (ACH) reported that there are free meetings available that he can get you linked with if interested. The morning session is a didactic learning session and the afternoon is a very engaged topical discussion with subjects brought by participating members.
  - b. Portage Path – conducting a virtual training session on August 27 for SBIRT that has 6 ceus and is free. Check the [ADM website](#) for more information.
